Dear Public Retiree:

The PEIP Retiree Health Program was implemented on July 1, 1996 for retired public employees age 65 or older (non State employees). The PEIP program features comprehensive benefits, attractive group rates and the choice of Blue Cross Blue Shield, HealthPartners, and UCare. The enclosed attachments give a brief overview of each plan option and the rates.

As a public retiree, both you and your spouse are eligible to enroll in the PEIP Retiree Health Program. To be eligible you must be enrolled in Medicare Parts A and B and have other health coverage currently in force. A physical examination or health statement is not required for participation.

The PEIP Retiree Health Program will offer an open enrollment for public retirees from October 1, 2017, through December 30, 2017, for a January 1, 2018 effective date.
